I was pleased to speak with you last week regarding the St. Agatha instrument and to learn that our firm is receiving serious consideration.

I hope that the rebuilt-revoiced pipe and the old pipe have arrived so you and the committee may be assured of the quality of this work. Use of rebuilt pipes as specified is certainly worthy of consideration.

I was able to obtain an excellent set of 16' Principal pipes from the Vanderbilt College organ in Nashville, Tennessee. These pipes are being shipped to us next week and I have them earmarked for rebuilding and revoicing for St. Agatha Church. They are included in the revised specification enclosed.

I have also added an independent 16' Posaune. This Pedal reed is unique in itself and a rebuilt set of pipes will not be possible without compromise of tonal result. Although quite expensive, I have chosen to supply all new pipes for this stop built to our specifications. They are to be full length.

I have gone one step further than our discussion in our revised recommendations and have brought the Hautbois from the Swell to the Pedal at 4' pitch. This will be an excellent solo voice and is worthy of the extra cost involved which would be roughly \$500. I hope that you will agree with this addition, but should you wish to delete it, the \$500. may be deducted from our quoted price.

I feel confident that this instrument will be as exciting in the church as it is in specified form on paper. We have ample room and as stated before, fine acoustics.
